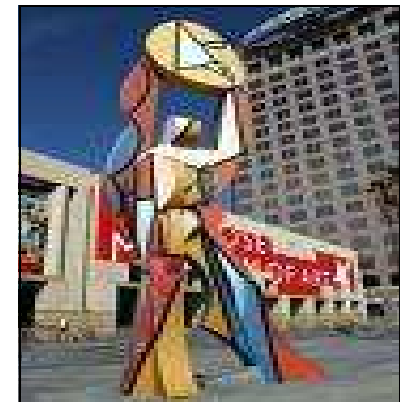
### **Cerebral Palsy Group**

The CP Group is a 501(c)3 organization comprised of adults with cerebral palsy (CP). The CP Group is a 501(c)3 organization comprised of adults with cerebral palsy (CP). The planning for The Group was initiated in response to the belief that they and other adults with CP were facing medical and social issues not being addressed by other organizations. CP is the most common major disabling motor disorder of childhood, and most research, social and educational programs to date have focused on infants and children. By the time an individual reaches age 18, there are few resources structured to address the specific problems faced by adults with CP. The CP Group, for example, is the only organization in the US whose membership is comprised almost entirely of adults with CP.
